## Foreword

Lattice 2013, the 31st International Symposium on Lattice Field Theory, was held in Mainz, Germany, during the week from July 29 to August 3, 2013. The conference was attended by 503 participants from 31 countries, making this the largest conference in this series so far.

In addition to the 24 plenary talks, an impressive 398 parallel talks and 81 posters were presented as part of the scientific programme. The conference schedule also included meetings of the network "Women in Lattice QCD" and the International Lattice Data Grid board meeting. The scientific part of the programme was accompanied by several social events, including a welcome reception, excursions and the conference banquet in the beautiful settings of the Mainz electoral palace.

Sadly, the conference was overshadowed by the deaths of two prominent members of the lattice community: On June 15, 2013, Nobel laureate Kenneth G. Wilson, the very founder of lattice field theory, passed away at the age of 77. Shortly before the start of the conference, we learned about the sudden and unexpected death of Mikhail Igorevich Polikarpov on July 18, 2013. Scientific obituaries for both of them are contained in these proceedings.

In compiling an interesting and vigorous scientific programme, the Local Organising Committee could rely on the wide-ranging expertise of the International Advisory Committee. Special thanks go to all session chairs, especially those who were willing to serve at short notice.
